Item 3: Language at the Annual General Meeting

KET approves the following statement: "Due to the changing composition of the community with a growing proportion of non-German-speaking participants, the language at the KET annual meeting will generally be English in future. Contributions or discussions in German will still be possible if the speaker or the topic requires it. The language of the informal discussion on Thursday evening will be chosen depending on the topic."

Item 4: German RECFA delegate

KET supports Heiko Lacker for a second term as German RECFA delegat and thanks him sincerely for his commitment.

Item 5: Preparation of the German input to the update of the European Strategy for Particle Physics

Heiko Lacker presents the timeline for input from the German HEP community. Three workshops with different focuses are proposed to be organised, including a final workshop at the end of January in Bad Honnef. This proposal will be discussed with the community at the upcoming Future Collider @ CERN Community Event. KET will liaise with the other committees regarding input to the strategy process.
