TOP 1: Minutes from last meeting

TOP 2: Chairman's report

TOP 3: Report from KET-Wahlvorstand

The "Wahlvorstand" reported about the status of nominations of candidates and of the compilation of the list of voters. All but one lists are completed. Candidates are being contacted at present. At least one candidate is already willing to stand for election in each region.

TOP 4: Letter to BMBF on ErUM-Pro funding

The present plan is presented and discussed. There is the suggestion to add the EIC to the LHeC talk, thus a better name is needed for this combined talk, e.g. lepton-hadron/ion collider or alike. Another suggestion is to foresee a bit more time for ILC+CLIC. The organizing committee will discuss this further.
